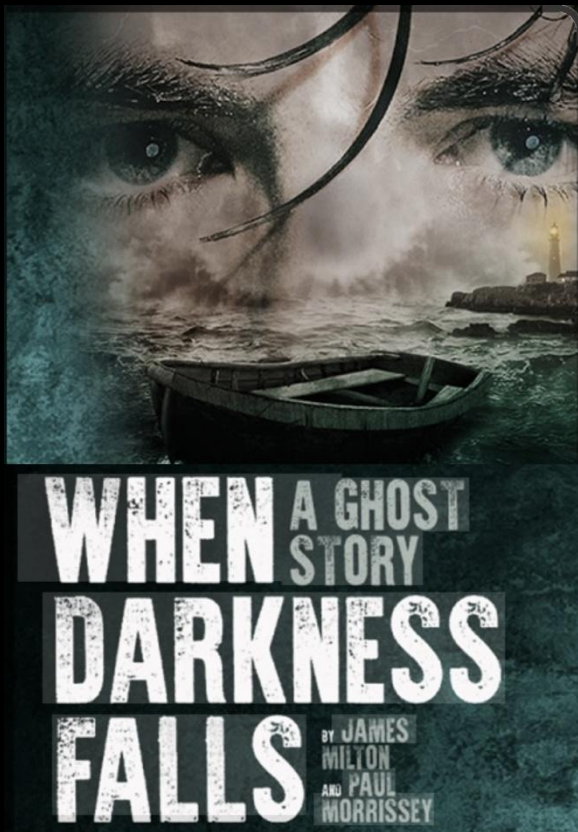

He has very wide support, including mine, and I fully expect that the AGM will confirm his appointment as the 2026/27 Theatre Manager and that he will be around in that position for many years.

And, importantly, no matter who is the Theatre Manager, the support of the old GOATS (*Group Of Active Theatre Seniors*) will be there as we enjoy theatre every Tuesday and Thursday morning at the Playhouse doing what the theatre manager and the next production need done to continue the 55 year run of success for CDS.

I heard your question – can I be part of the old Goats too? Of course – all are welcome but we do have a few constraints. We tend to be retired people – male or female – who have spare time during the day. At the moment we meet most Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to about 11:30 a.m. and we do stuff – whatever needs doing that we have the skills to do. When finished for the morning, we adjourn to the foyer for refreshment and a chat. Can the time change? Yes – it is up to the group – but the idea is to use daytime rather than evening because the Goats are generally retired people and daytime works for supervising external technicians, accepting deliveries and constructing or deconstructing sets.

Thanks for being a part of my theatre career for these past years. I have really appreciated all of the help – and the thanks – that I have received. Let's do the same now for Chad Powell, ably supported by his wife Cynthia...
